This service allows you to authorize the People's City Mission to deduct your monthly gift from your checking or savings account. **We save time and money and more of our guests will be helped!**

- Fill out, sign and date this form.
- Include a copy of a voided check or savings deposit slip.

Each deduction will appear on your monthly bank statement. You will not receive a receipt from us unless requested. You will receive a Year End Statement by January 31st of the next year for the previous year. You can notify us at any time, in writing, to increase/decrease the amount or stop the transactions.
